IRISH ANSWER raced off the pace, waited for room in traffic passing the furlong marker, angled inside and surged late on the hedge to get up. PEACEFUL SOLUTION raced close up inside, angled out for running room, closed gamely in the three path and just missed in a driving finish. SUPER NEKIA vied three wide from the outside, and dug in gamely between foes late. VOODOO'S RUN stalked early on and finished well outside. BEACON BEACH vied between rivals and was outfinished. KNOCKOUT PUNCH was bumped at the start, raced between foes into the lane and lacked a winning bid. MING DYNASTY vied inside and weakened. SHOW LOW did not factor. FERBER was bumped at the start and outrun.
