COURT BAND raced close up inside, swung wide turning for home, rallied outside, lugged in late and got up in the final strides. IL POSTINO vied between rivals, bumped AWESOME CHARLIE at the top of the stretch, then drifted out in midstretch and dug in gamely to the finish. LOVE CONQUERS raced four wide early, contested the pace three wide, rallied between foes in the stretch and was steadied late behind the winner. C STREET settled off the pace, advanced inside on the far turn, rallied between rivals and was bumped and forced to steady late. AWESOME CHARLIE vied inside, was bumped and forced to steady at the top of the stretch, then weakened. RUFF AND READY raced off the rail and had no rally. CRACK THE OPUS stalked outside, came wide and lacked a rally. GIFT OF VALOR did not factor. CURRAGH (ARG) did not factor. After a Stewards' Inquiry and Jockey's Objections concerning the stretch run, COURT BAND was disqualified and placed third, and IL POSTINO was disqualified and placed fourth.
