Footnotes

KISSAMEE GLITTER was reserved for a half, rapidly closed the gap from outside to reach contention on the turn, drifted out while challenging in midstretch and prevailed after a long drive. MATTER OF STYLE pressed the early pace between horses, opened a clear advantage along the backstretch, maintained a clear lead in upper stretch then yielded grudgingly. BACHATA was reserved for a half, lodged a rally from outside on the turn and finished willingly to gain a share. LENAPE LOU settled just off the early pace, moved up three wide on the far turn, closed the gap from outside nearing the stretch and weakened late. PLATINUM LACE raced well back for six furlongs and rallied belatedly. ROSAMUND failed to mount a serious rally. MAY WE DANCE raced just off the pace along the rail for six furlongs and faded in the stretch. FONDLY was never a factor. DANCEY JEN chased between horses for five furlongs and faltered. RICKETTS MILL GAL gave way abruptly on the turn.
