DISARONA stalked the leader, bid two wide on the far turn, wore down SUPAH JALENE in midstretch and drew clear late, driving. SUPAH JALENE set the pace racing with a clear lead, dug in gamely when challenged and yielded. MALIBU MURMUR settled off the inside and rallied mildly for third. LOOKS LIKE SIS raced off the pace between rivals, saved ground on the far turn and failed to sustain a bid. CHRISTMAS ANGEL saved ground and failed to threaten. ROCKHARD N NOBLE had a three wide trip, made a mild bid on the far turn and weakened. JEAN'S SURPRISE saved ground and lacked a rally. WET ONE (IRE) stumbled at the start, raced three wide, bid four wide on the turn, gave way, then was pulled up nearing the finish and vanned off.
