MISTY'S SONG vied inside early on, then tracked along the hedge, bid between rivals midway on the far turn, dueled in upper stretch and drew clear under urging. NORTH LIGHT LADY vied four wide on the backside, bid three wide at the quarter pole, dug in and came up second best. MY WILD IRISH ROSE vied three wide, took over entering the far turn, dueled inside and stayed on well. SUGAR LOVE vied between rivals, chased between and weakened. FLOWER PATCH raced on the hedge and failed to sustain a bid. FIDDLERS COLEEN stalked, was steadied at the five sixteenths and tired. SPLENDID AGAIN saved ground to no avail. MARGALO saved ground and tired. MIZZ LIZA raced four wide early, moved up five wide to contest the pace on the backside and faded. MS. BANAJA did not factor.
