GHOST TRACKER raced off the pace, made a three wide bid entering the final turn, drew off and held well late under a drive. BOW TIE raced off the pace, moved up on the far turn, rallied outside and was gaining late. UNDER SHIRT saved ground and lacked a winning bid. LEAVE IT TO BERN was outrun early, moved up and passed tired rivals. DESERT PEPPER raced inside and failed to respond. BALTHUS raced close up inside and failed to respond. SHAHADAROBA tracked the early leader, made a bid on the backside and gave way. BARRISTER BAY raced off the hedge and showed little. CROOKSHANE LAD set the pace and stopped. CIMMERON SAM raced far back.
