Footnotes

STEVE'S BIG MOE stalked the leaders from three wide while never far back, moved to challenge into the far turn, continued from outside C O RINGO into the lane and edged clear late. C O RINGO was on the pace from outside SHEER CLASS through the opening half mile, was joined by the winner into the far turn then continued with that one to deep stretch before yielding late. BRAND FORTY FOUR was forced out over a rivals heels and went wide in the first turn as that rival bore out, recovered to rally four and five wide through the far turn and finished up willingly after a rough beginning. BABYJAKE'S ON TIME was fractious in the gate then broke a bit slowly, stalked the pace racing out from the rail and lacked a closing bid. SHEER CLASS contested the pace from inside C O RINGO to the far turn and weakened nearing the stretch. SWEET VIOLET was not a factor racing two and three wide. SIGN ME UP bobbled at the start, saved ground and was outrun. INDIAN FLAME tired racing four wide. SAM DIEGO lugged in at the break and going to the first turn then soon after quickly bore out entering that bend, chased the leaders while wide and gave way in the far turn.
