HALO'S ROCKET set all the pace and held gamely in the drive to be clear under strong pressure. RECAST pressed the pace along the inside and finished second best. FIRE UP THE BELL was bumped at the start, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and made a good late bid. BLAKE RATTLENROLL pressed the pace while racing between rivals and tired. SOLID SILVER STAR was bumped at the start, saved ground and never threatened. SHARP MOVE failed to sustain a bid. HUXLEY HALL stalked the pace, raced four wide and weakened in the lane. MALIBU MIDAS failed to menace.
