Footnotes

READY TO TAUNT just off the pace just off the inside, took closer order as the field stacked up five across the track at the head of the stretch, swung three wide at that juncture between foes set down for the drive, rallied to take command nearing the eighth pole, inched away to the sixteenth, dug in under a drive to hold off a belated surge and prevail. LURE OF THE SOUTH three wide towards the rear, came under encouragement three furlongs out, spun five wide into the stretch, angled out a path for clearance by a tiring a rival at the three-sixteenths, rallied belatedly to cut into the aforementioned rival's margin and threaten in the final strides but was forced to settle for the place honors. FREE BRAVE tracked the pace along the inside from mid pack, was on hold in behind a wall of rivals stacked across the track while swinging three to four wide in upper stretch, angled out at the three-sixteenths presented the clearance when TAPROOT retreated, got roused once shifted, fought on to the finish offering a mild kick to procure the show. RANGEY away sharply at the start,

made the pace along the inside under light coaxing, got set down cutting the corner into the stretch, got displaced nearing the eighth pole, kept on mildly until weakening in the final sixteenth safe for the last major share. TORMENT just off the inside towards the rear, commenced a three to four wide bid in tandem with TAPROOT from the half mile pole advancing to contention swinging four wide at the head of the lane, kicked on to the eighth pole then flattened out in the final furlong. FOOLISH TIGER two to three wide in close pursuit asked from the five-sixteenths, weakened in the stretch. KINGS VILLAGE attended the pace from just off the inside, lost position and faded nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner at that station and tired. TAPROOT three wide in mid pack, made a four wide bid in tandem with TORMENT to his inside from the half mile pole, progressed into prominence swinging five wide for home, straightened away under a drive and gave way at the three-sixteenths. JET SET CAT saved ground towards the rear, ranged up inside at the five-eighths pole to be within aim, retreated through the turn and tired.
