Footnotes

STREET THUG set the pace from along the inside, vied from the seven-sixteenths when ARKANSAS JOE ranged up to engage the front at that juncture, sped off with that foe clear from the rest of the field, was let out at the quarter pole with that rival still in hot pursuit, shied from the whip nearing the eighth pole bumping lightly with ARKANSAS JOE, had that opponent safely at bay nearing the wire with ESCAPE ARTIST bearing down in the last few strides along the rail and just held on at the wire. ESCAPE ARTIST reserved off the pace, saved ground throughout, cut the corner into the lane improving position, rolled into prominence along the rail with an eighth remaining, rallied belatedly inside and just missed. ARKANSAS JOE initially chased the front three wide, settled into the two path in the turn, engaged the front at the seven-sixteenths under light coaxing, sped off with that rival well clear of the rest through the turn, was able to get within a nostril of the leader at the head of the lane under a drive, ran on well through the lane, was bumped nearing the eighth pole holding well to the end for show honors. SCOUT'S HONOR off a beat slow at the start, was pushed along from the three-eighths pole while three wide through the turn, swung five wide in upper stretch, offered up a mild bid for the last major share. TRANSPLENDENT midpack under reserve initially, swung four wide in upper stretch and offered up a mild kick by tiring rivals. DOUBLE BASS settled in the two path in close pursuit of the front, patiently waited as that pair sped off through the turn, was put to encouragement approaching the head of the lane and stayed on through the same pace to the wire. KEY TO POWER reserved off the pace, swung six wide at the quarter pole and was no factor. Z VILNA in close pursuit early on, chased three to four wide in the turn and faded after a half. REVOLVING settled in midpack, was placed to a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths while taking the overland route in the turn and tired. RELENTLESS ROAD unsettled early on while showing brief speed and in contention, steadily lost position through the turn, was eased through the final eighth.
