Footnotes

SILVER OVER GOLD raced three wide for most of the way around the turn, was kept in hand, awaiting suitable options for a sixteenth of a mile, starting from the five-sixteenths pole, came under encouragement spinning into the lane, altered course to be outside all front runners approaching the end of the run through the furlong grounds, gained readily on the runner up after finishing this maneuver, apparently with no loss of momentum, took over in the final seventy yards and edged away under brisk hand urging. SURROUND SOUND got away last, after lunging at the start, responded well to some hand urging and settled into midpack before reaching the end of the backstretch, entered the turn from the four path, steadily advanced into contention, was still well off the rail issuing a challenge for command as the three front runners turned for home, soon gained the lead and edged away, felt the winner's presence by the

sixteenth pole, offered good resistance before yielding in the late stages. ROMAN RENEGADE under a good hold, saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole, was kept to that hold until the head of the stretch, came home with good energy to secure the show. LANDING MY WAY three wide entering the turn, was in the five path departing it, displayed a mild response to take the final major slice of the pot. AMPLY REWARDED between rivals, came up empty when asked for run at the midway point on the turn. SUNNYBROOK chased the early pacesetter from the three path, went by that rival shortly before going a half, was under encouragement entering the stretch with another pair in hot pursuit, held her ground for a little while longer, yielded and backed away. CARMELLA CEE off the inside, was through after completing a half. REAL GLORY was never a menace. SYSTEM READY along the rail on the turn, faltered. CHAKA BWANA showed the way from the two path for about three furlongs before retreating.
