FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$3,000 in addition to the entry fee can be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees to receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Any horse that competes in both the Westchester and Metropolitan Handicap will have their entry fee waived for the Metropolitan Handicap. Three year olds, 118.; Older 123. Non-winners of \$60,000 in 2013 allowed 2 lbs.; Non winners of a graded sweepstakes since October 1, 2012, 4 lbs.; 4 races, 6 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming, Starter and Restrictd allowance races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, April 13, 2013 with 40 Nominations.

Footnotes

FLAT OUT allowed to settle two to three wide within aim of the front, shifted out a path to advance four wide from the half mile pole under light coaxing through the turn, moved into contention coming to the quarter pole, got set down for the drive at that station, dug in through the stretch to wear down the determined CROSS TRAFFIC in the final strides and prevail in a game effort. CROSS TRAFFIC ranged up early on to establish the front, cut the pace from just off the inside while racing in hand, had the pressure intensify three furlongs out, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths in response, cut the corner into the stretch inching away briefly, got confronted inside the final furlong, dug in fighting on gamely to the wire but was nailed in the final jumps. RATTLESNAKE BRIDGE coaxed along inside to take closer order at the half mile pole, continued to save ground within range through the turn coming under further encouragement midway, faded nearing the quarter pole, angled four wide in upper stretch and weakened in the drive while reasserting himself enough to recapture the show honors. BIG SCREEN broke alertly from the gate, settled to attend CROSS TRAFFIC from the three path through solid splits, raced between rivals from the three-eighths pole to the five-sixteenths as FLAT OUT ranged up outside, got set down at the quarter pole now giving chase in behind the front pair, offered no serious response and tired in the final furlong. NORMAN ASBJORNSON two to three wide at the rear, came under a ride three furlongs from home, angled four to five wide in upper stretch and trailed.
