Footnotes

GALLANT BREEZE contently stalked the pacesetter from the outside, moved when ready coming to the five-sixteenths pole and took over under his own power, turned for home and drew out to his biggest advantage during the ensuing furlong, had the rider atop in the saddle indifferent as the margin was chopped down in size belatedly, finishing the event handily. MILESMORE came outward and was bumped solidly, raced from off the inside, ducked over to the rail as the front runners all chose wider routes to take into the stretch, didn't stay along the rail for too long though, eventually being paced, in two stages, into the four path by midstretch, made a deceptive late gain on the unasked winner en route to getting up for the place. RETIRED was squeezed after being bumped from both sides at the break, raced three wide on the turn, entered the stretch with the rider applying some stick work, got outfinished for place honors. CAMERON CANYON rated in the two path while cutting the pace, succumbed readily when confronted by the top one late on the bend. UNBRIDLED BAND four wide on the turn, had no rally. UPROARIOUS GEORGE bobbed after being bumped a short distance out of the starting gate, tucked along inside before reaching the end of the backstretch and rode the rail for nearly the whole way around the bend, swung three wide into the stretch, had no offering. CIRCADIA came inward after stumbling at the start, bumped with rivals after having done so and again a few strides later, raced from off the rail and was through after completing three-quarters.
