(Maiden, claiming, and starter allowance races not considered in allowances). A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Friday, April 22, 2011 with 26 Nominations. CHORUS MUSIC was unhurried for nearly three-quarters, was let out a bit swinging four wide into the stretch, gained rapidly between the head of the stretch and the eighth pole, surged by to take over then drew off under a vigorous hand ride. EXCLUSIVE SCHEME quickly established command, cut the pace towards the inside being pressed by a hard to handle IN TE DOMINE throughout the opening half, edged clear from that opponent, after being lightly urged, came under assault from the top one in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, was unable to keep up, giving in readily, but held well enough to the end to save the place. AKILINA raced along the outside and displayed good energy down the center of the course to earn the show. FREEDOM RINGS saved ground until the quarter pole, angled outward to be widest of all and finished willingly to improve position. PARAIBA bobbled at the start, took up chase on the front runners while kept off the inside, angled three wide for the stretch run but lacked the needed response. LADY GRACENOTE along the inside, was asked for a response at the five-sixteenths pole but failed to deliver. IN TE DOMINE appeared eager and full of run from the get-go, rushed up to take up a forward position, resisting the rider's attempt to rate, continued an aggressive pursuit on the leader, requiring the jockey to steady at various points down the backstretch to throttle down the mount, managed to keep pace with the front runner until midpoint on the turn and tired.
