STYLISH FELLA bumped with IGUAZU just out of the starting gate, settled into the pocket soon afterwards, patiently tracked the leader, was forced to remain on hold, lacking options as the field neared the quarter pole, had intentions of angling outward in upper stretch, but was denied when DUCALE stubbornly held his ground, caught sight of a seam between rivals just past the three-sixteenths pole, readily went for it, slithered between rivals to gain the lead at the eighth pole then edged clear under good handling. IGUAZU made contact with the winner soon after the start, saved ground around the turn, cut the corner under a full drive, advanced along the now unobstructed rail to loom boldly with a furlong to go, continued on with good courage the rest of the way but had to settle for the place. PAYOUT cut the pace along the inside, was set down turning for home, got overhauled midstretch and weakened slightly into the show slot. DUCALE urged from the gate, prompted the pacesetter from the outside until upper stretch and weakened. FORTY PRAYERS saved ground and rallied mildly. GOLD PROSPECT within range throughout the opening half, was placed five wide at the head of the stretch and tired. VIRTUES

UNDER FIRE had no rally. SOUND CHASER was no menace. WHO'S WILLIE FITZ under a snug hold between rivals until the seven-sixteenths pole, lacked a solid closing punch. TONY'S BACK three wide, was through after a half. GOLDEN TEMPLE hit the right side of the starting gate, was always well back of the rest of the field and was eased during the last eighth.
