AVENGING SPIRIT gained command soon after the start, was guided over to the inside in time for the run around the bend, began to edge away from the competition when asked for some run coming to the five-sixteenths pole, emerged from the furlong grounds with a comfortable advantage and held sway. SUN DANCE MOON sat reserved in the two path for nearly six furlongs, came four wide for the stretch drive and rallied willingly to procure the place. SURE SUCCESS took up residence along the inside coming to the half mile pole, launched a rail bid heading into the stretch but could not sustain the move during the last eighth. SAGINAW made contact with SENIORS PRIDE shortly after leaving the gate, sat within striking distance along the outside until the quarter pole, turned for home in the four path but got out finished. SENIORS PRIDE bumped with SAGINAW a short distance from the starting gate, accompanied the pacesetter from the outside for three-quarters and gave way. MORE THAN A REASON sluggish at the start, lagged behind along the inside during the initial half, vacated the rail departing the backstretch, swung five wide for the stretch run but had no offering. HERMOSILLO underwent a three wide pursuit and folded.
