TOP YANK easily out sprinted the competition to establish control, angled over to the inside quickly, was rated on the lead facing only mild resistance, came under stronger and stronger handling leaving the five-sixteenths pole, gearing up for the stretch run, took off with a good display of acceleration when finally given his cue in upper stretch, then drew away being briskly hand urged almost to the wire. GETINITALLTOGETHER came away in good order and was allowed to settle into stride, raced along the outside, was given some rein early on the turn but made up only a minimal amount of ground, turned for home five wide under encouragement, settling into upper stretch, the widest off all, took off in earnest after being straightened away, rapidly shot past rivals with a good turn of speed, under a strong drive all the while, and eventually secured the place, while never posing a threat to the top one at any time. DIGITAL JOE chased from the outside for a half before backing away. GUDAHAI broke on top but soon surrendered the front to the winner, underwent a three wide pursuit and steadily tired after completing a half. LAKE AND LUDLOW between foes on the turn, had no rally. UP IN SMOKE took the inside route, was

coaxed along tracking the pacesetter and faltered. UNBRIDLED RUNAWAY raced along the outside and failed to muster up the necessary stretch response. LLOYDOBLER saved ground, was urged on the turn but could make no headway on the front runners. VAMEL saved ground and was outrun. KEYALY broke outward a bit leaving the gate, left the backstretch four wide, was asked for a response coming to the five-sixteenths pole but had little left to offer by this point. TACTICAL SALUTE saved ground until the quarter pole. FIELD AGENT rode the rail and was outrun.
