Footnotes

ROUGH WINTER gave chase from off the inside, was under strong handling spinning into the stretch, closed in on the front runners readily during the run through the furlong grounds, continued onward while being kept to a strong drive, nailed the second place finisher in the last jump to gain the verdict. BELIEVE IN BETTY sat well placed in the two path off the contested pace, was maneuvered to be three wide coming to the five-sixteenths pole, in preparation for the stretch drive, drove her way to the front by midstretch, establishing herself as the clear leader, tried to dig in and fend off the winner, but failed, losing the bob at the finish line. OUR PINK RIBBON argued for control from the inside, got let out approaching the head of the stretch, yielded before arriving at the furlong marker and eventually weakened into the show slot. GIVING ME FITZ in midpack in the early going, was taken in hand after the incident occurred at the top of the turn, was put to encouragement angling outward in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, commenced her stretch drive

from the five path at the top of the lane and held on well to grab the last major slice of the pot. RED CODE underwent a three wide pursuit, lacked the necessary stretch response. SIBERIAN WILDCAT sparred in the two path and gave way. FALL INTO FAITH broke inward at the start, taking RENNINA along for a short ride, raced four wide for most of the way around the turn, failed to reach a contending position. CONNECT WITH TRAZ well off the inside, was outrun. DITA saved ground, was urged along on the turn but could make no headway on the front runners. RENNINA got carried in slightly by an errant foe at the start, settled near the middle of the field from off the inside, was momentarily grabbed hold in reaction to the spill in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, then had the rider cast a wary look in the direction of the loose horse soon afterwards all the while travelling three wide around the turn, came into the stretch with the rider less rival directly to the inside, had the pilot grab hold of that one's reins as a protective measure for an abbreviated portion of the stretch run in upper lane, then fell back steadily. MAJESTIC TWELVE along the outside, was taken up by the rider, being affected the most by the spill, leaving the half mile pole and was outrun thereafter. CHUBBALITA'S JOY got away slowly, was rushed up the rail under hand encouragement, was still moving willingly along the inside with little room to spare, when she hit the rail hard just prior to the seven-sixteenths pole, unseating the rider in the process. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the incident on the turn before the result was declared official.
