Footnotes

ALARMIST bumped at the start from his inside by a rival breaking outward, was placed three wide in close pursuit of the pacemaker while in reserve, came under coaxing nearing the head of the lane, displaced the front at the quarter pole, edged clear through the stretch being kept busy to the end. BACK CATCHA ERIC sat in the two path in midpack in behind the front, came under hand urging at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide in upper stretch, rallied mildly through the initial portion of the lane, displayed late energy to secure the place from a weakening pace setter in the late stages. MISSILE NICK set the pace inside under light coaxing, came under a drive when confronted nearing the top of the lane, got displaced on the front at that station, ran on holding well until weakening in the late stages and settled for the show honors. POINT AND GO accompanied the pace setter from the two path, was let out at the quarter pole, displayed a mild kick through the lane being out kicked by the top three while clear for the last major share. ALI'S WINNER broke out at the start bumping with ALARMIST before being taken off that rival, chased the front four wide throughout, was called upon nearing the top of the stretch and offered no response. SMOKIN CANDY reserved off the pace, came under hand urging midway on the turn while chasing three wide and offered little. THANK HANK outrun in the early stages, raced four to five wide through the turn and was never a factor. POINT TO KARAKORUM off a beat slow, came under hustling to be forwardly placed along the inside showing brief speed, continued the prolonged drive throughout the turn while losing position and tired after a half.
