DIVINE PARK settled in good position along the backstretch while four wide, continued wide while rapidly closing the gap at the quarter pole, charged to the front opening a commanding lead in upper stretch and drew away with authority. GRASSHOPPER was reserved for a half between rivals, angled five wide at the quarter pole, drifted out in midstretch and finished willingly. SIGHTSEEING was outrun along the inside for five furlongs, swung six wide at the quarter pole and rallied mildly from outside. MINER'S LAMP stumbled badly at the start, raced well back along the inside, gained slightly leaving the turn and lacked a late response. MR. UMPHREY pressed the pace from outside to the top of the stretch and tired. SAINT DAIMON set the pace under pressure along the rail into upper stretch and gave way.
