Footnotes

IRISH MAJESTY moved out while unhurried along the backstretch, worked his way forward in the two path to reach contention leaving the turn, split horses while gaining in upper stretch then wore down MARINA MARKET after a long drive in the final seventy yards. MARINA MARKET was well placed behind the pacesetter for six furlongs, rapidly closed the gap in upper stretch, opened a clear advantage in midstretch then yielded late while drifting out slightly. FRIENDLY POCKET trailed for a half, made a sharp five wide move to reach contention at the quarter pole and flattened out a bit in the late stages. GOLDEN MAN raced in midpack from outside for a half, gained three wide to reach contention midway on the turn and lacked a strong closing response. FRENCH TRANSITION broke slowly, steadied briefly midway down the backstretch then failed to mount a serious rally while saving ground. KING MOBAY raced up close in the two path for a half, dropped back on the far turn and steadily tired thereafter. TIGER D. R. sprinted clear soon after the start, raced uncontested on the front while saving ground for six furlongs and gave way badly in upper stretch.
