Footnotes

RIGHT OF WAY was well placed just off the early leaders, advanced three wide to close the gap on the turn, split rivals four wide entering the stretch, surged to the front in midstretch and held off the runner-up under good handling. DANCING TIN MAN was reserved for a half, worked his way forward four wide on the turn then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. CLOSE TO THE VEST sprinted clear on the rail, led into midstretch and weakened. TYPHOON TYCOON saved ground early, launched a move between horses entering the stretch and rallied mildly. MISSINGLISALEWIS checked at the start, moved up in hand along the rail, raced within striking distance to the top of the stretch and lacked a strong closing response. CALL TIGER pressed the pace in the two path for five furlongs and tired. BAD ACTION never reached contention after breaking slowly. MACCARIB PASS was never a factor after breaking slowly. ELIXIR stalked four wide to the top of the stretch and gave way.
