Footnotes

JOHANNESBURG SMILE away from the starting gate in good order, established control soon during the run down the backstretch, set the pace from two path under rating tactics, remained on hold until the three-sixteenths pole, angled inward at that point, causing his closest pursuer to steady momentarily, increased his advantage under brisk hand urging until the furlong marker, then was placed under stronger encouragement to maintain a safe margin. JIMMY VEGAS underwent an inside pursuit, briefly lost contact after leaving the half mile pole, got back to within good striking distance after being asked for run, steadied momentarily when the top one came over at the three-sixteenths pole, altered course outward, finished with good courage but had to settle for place honors. SUCCESS FEE saved ground and proved to be no match for the top pair during the stretch run. ITSAGOODTENDOLLARS stalked the pacesetter three wide for three-quarters before backing off. TOMMASI was no factor. SUMMER SHARE, broke open the gate prior to the start, sat reserved during the initial half, attempted a four wide sweep after entering the turn, but flattened out. UNDOCUMENTED raced along the outside and trailed.
