UNION ARMY reserved off the inside, was asked for run midway around the far turn, tipped outward after turning for home, sustained his momentum as he closed in on the front runners, then proved best nearing the wire. PARKINSON FIELD under a good hold three wide, issued his challenge for the lead approaching the quarter pole, fought his way to the front just past the eighth pole, clung to the advantage with determination before yielding in the late stages. GILT EDGED took the inside route, was forced to be kept on hold, surrounded by rivals as the field headed for the quarter pole, angled free in upper stretch, but could muster up only a mild kick to be along for the show. JACOB'S DREAM prompted the pace from the outside, made a successful move to the lead on the far turn, succumbed a couple of strides leaving the furlong grounds and steadily weakened thereafter. SPECIALE GIORNO was no factor. FESTIVO ducked over to the inside down the backstretch once sufficiently clear, showed the way while continuing to race towards the rail, came under assault approaching the top of the stretch, and gave way readily. UNFORGETTABLE P J was outrun. ALI'S JOY took the inside route, was through after completing three-quarters, and eased in the lane.
