### Footnotes

FRAZZIE left well and grabbed a forward spot, tucked into the two path in time for the run around the bend, continued to press the leader, went on to wrest away the lead by the eighth pole, came outward in deep stretch after being on the receiving end of constant left handed pressure, bumping with and blocking OLIVE EYE the remainder of the way. MOONWALK BEAUTY stalked the front runners from the outside, gained readily throughout the stretch drive but was denied. OLIVE EYE left alertly, was taken in hand soon after breaking out of the gate to sit a pocket journey, remained patiently placed there for the opening half, commenced to rally after entering the stretch, altered course to the right a couple of paths at the eighth pole, was gaining ground fast on the unofficial winner, when that one rival crossed over into her path, making contact, and causing the rider to steady when locked in behind the entire final seventy yards. ENVOYEZ VITE hustled to the lead, vied for command while saving ground, was put to a frantic drive from the quarter pole, relinquished the front a furlong later and steadily weakened thereafter. SOUNDS FREUDIAN saved ground for nearly a half, angled three wide into the lane, but had no meaningful offering to render. POSEY PARK three wide around the turn, was through after completing a half. COME A CALLIN raced along the outside and was no factor. SODA KAPS saved ground until the quarter pole, After a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the stretch run, as well as a claim of foul lodged by the rider of OLIVE EYE against the rider of FRAZZIE alleging interference, the latter was disqualified from first and placed third for causing interference in deep stretch.
