FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$1,000 in addition to the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Any horse that competes in both the Westchester and Metropolitan will have their entry fee waived for the Metropolitan Three year olds, 118.; Older 123. Non-winners of \$60,000 in 2011 allowed 2 lbs.; Non winners of a graded sweepstakes since October 1, 2010, 4 lbs.; 4 races, 6 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming, Starter and Restriced allowance races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, April 16, 2011 with 30 Nominations.

CAIXA ELETRONICA assumed a forward position down the chute, was lightly urged prompting the pacesetter towards the two path, continued along on the same scenario for nearly three-quarters, crept up to the pacesetter, with the rider still attempting to keep something in reserve, departing the five-sixteenths pole, was released from that hold and quickly shook free, left the furlong grounds the clear-cut leader and drew away, being kept to the task at hand. CONVOCATION reserved off the inside, began to pick up interest under some encouragement from midway on the turn, angled three wide for the stretch drive, under much stronger handling by this point and rallied willingly to procure the place. SCHOOLYARD DREAMS unhurried for six furlongs, commenced to rally from the three path at the head of the stretch and displayed a good, but belatedly kick to grab the show. HAYNESFIELD took the inside route, sat under a snug hold, was forced to wait, lacking options throughout the run around the bend, managed his way into the two path soon after entering the lane but failed to fire once called upon. CHRISTMAS FOR LIAM took control a short distance from the starting gate, set a lively clip, rated slightly off the inside, offered brief resistance before relinquishing the lead to the top one at the three-sixteenths pole and steadily weakened thereafter.
