SPANISH ART reserved while racing off the rail, swung into action nearing the quarter pole, was stacked five to six wide at the top of the lane, took off after the leader once roused, readily gobbled up real estate during the run through the furlong grounds, took charge leaving the eighth pole and drew clear. GATHERING CLOUD prompted the pacesetter from the outside while not being asked for his best, made his bid for the lead once ready, turning for home, took over briefly past the furlong marker, was overhauled by the top one, but continued on well to preserve the place. CHEYENNE NATION saved ground until midway around the far turn, angled outward after gaining clearance, loosely drafted behind the eventual winner into the stretch, settled into a good rally after being straightened away, displaying a good late kick down the outside of the course to grab show honors. SANTA raced towards the inside, was urged on the second turn, advanced forward to loom momentarily with a furlong remaining, but could not sustain the bid. TAPIT'S BREW saved ground, swung three wide at the quarter pole and finished well. PERSON OF INTEREST stalked three wide and tired during the final eighth. ROYAL STRAIGHT set the pace towards the rail until midstretch and gave way. CAFE DES ARTISTES a forward factor for six furlongs, tired. STREET HOCKEY was never in contention. BEIJING BLUES (ARG) raced off the inside, was asked for run on the second turn and folded.
