GLACIER BAY took the inside route, was asked for a response coming to the five-sixteenths pole, began to angle off the hedge after gaining clearance, turned for home three wide, tipped almost immediately one lane wider, took off earnest after the front runners upon completion off all maneuvers, accelerated by RETIRE TO WHAT a short distance past the sixteenth pole and edged clear, driving. SUMFUN sat within range off the inside, swung five wide into the stretch under encouragement and displayed a good kick down the center of the course to garner place honors. SLY saved ground until the quarter pole, turned for home already having been called upon, split rivals with good energy in deep stretch en route for the show. AMERICAN CLASSIC stalked from the outside and got out finished. RETIRE TO WHAT was urged from the gate to outsprint the field for the lead, set lively fractions while racing along the hedge, emerged from the furlong grounds with a comfortable advantage, was soon overhauled and steadily weakened thereafter. CAYO HUESO

pressed from two path and faltered after completing a half. CLOSE TO THE VEST chased three wide around the turn before backing away. ONZAIN three wide at the half mile pole, failed to reach a contending position. CAN'T REFUSE raced along the outside and was no factor. THE CUFF SHOOTER off the rail on the turn, never menaced. I'LL MAKE IT UP came out a bit, brushing with the nearest rival, was steadied and outrun thereafter.
