Footnotes

FIVESTAR KARAKORUM left the backstretch four wide, raced forwardly placed, a bit more closer to the inside for most of the run around the bend, spun three wide into upper stretch, with the runner up tightly wedged between himself and the pacesetter, dueled with CENTRIPITAL from the three-sixteenths pole to the sixteenth pole, took over past that station and edged away. CENTRIPITAL saved ground, took off with a good turn of speed after the reins were shaken approaching the five-sixteenths pole, slipped off the rail and squeezed his way into the two path turning for home, grabbed a narrow lead, was soon confronted by the top one, fought well for an additional furlong before relinquishing, but dug in with good determination thereafter to preserve the place. ALLEN'S AFFAIR was bumped while in tight quarters between rivals jockeying for position in the vicinity of the five-eighths pole, was placed in the two path departing the backstretch, got asked early for a response and rallied well enough to be along for the show. JUDY'S WARRIOR in tight between rivals early down the backstretch, got bumped, went on to assume a forward position, was forced to await options from midpoint on the turn to the five-sixteenths pole, angled eagerly towards an available seam at that juncture, turned for home four wide, made a mild advance during the ensuing furlong but could not sustain the bid. SPENCERIFIC acted up just prior to the gate being sprung open, striking the left side with his nose to get off slowly, failed to reach a contending position thereafter. TINDARO'S PROSPECT set the pace slightly off the inside and gave way. LOOK TO THE FUTURE was taken in hand after being bumped early down the backstretch, swung outside and remained in the three path upon reaching the half mile pole, continued well off the inside and tired. STAR WITNESS jostled with several rivals soon after the start and was outrun. READ ABOUT ME stalked from the outside for a half and tired.
