Footnotes

MAKE IT GOLD came way without apparent mishap, took control and was guided over to the inside route, cut the pace being rated along and with the runner up keeping a vigilant watch just off his hind quarters, had that foe launch an abbreviated challenge prior to the third fraction being recorded, rebuffed it and was kept comfortably in the clear thereafter. GRIDIRON GREAT contently stalked the leader from off the inside, briefly increased his presence coming to the five-sixteenths marker, got staved off and had to settle for being second best. HORSE LATITUDES tracked the winner from the pocket and proved no match. BOOGIE TOO underwent a three wide journey, scurried into contention during the run around the full turn, couldn't sustain the move and flattened out. MUSCLES MARINARA departed the inside route at the end of the backstretch, had no rally. INMYFATHERSIMAGE saved ground for over three-quarters, swung outward entering the stretch until four wide with an eighth to go, made no headway. PASS THE TAP saved ground to no avail. THE CULCHIE raced three wide, failed to respond when asked to at the three-eighths pole, began to back away soon afterwards and was eased.
