JAGUAR PAW contently tracked a threesome along the inside route in the early going, was asked for run to out race AWESOME VISION for the four path leaving the three-eighths pole, challenged in earnest as the widest of a tightly-bunched quartet, forged his way to the lead by the furlong marker and kicked clear. SUMMER SUNSET travelled three wide on the turn, ranged up towards another pair late on the turn to increase his presence, bid for command from between rivals spinning into the lane, failed to keep up with the top one but held on well for the place. SMASH rated in the two path while forwardly placed for nearly three-quarters, got outfinished. AWESOME VISION raced from off the inside, was shaken up and asked for pick up the pace departing the backstretch, angled outward with the eventual winner following suit shortly afterwards, got out sprinted for the four path coming to the five-sixteenths pole, swung five wide into the stretch, lacked a solid closing punch. COLIZEO vied for the lead from the rail, came under heavy pressure heading for the quarter pole and readily succumbed.
