Footnotes

BRIDGEVILLE made light contact with HARRYTHENAVIGATOR right after the start, sat forwardly placed in the two path, got set down for the drive home, took over nearing the wire. MUSCLES MARINARA three to four wide at the three-eighths pole, rallied willingly to beat a pack of rivals for place honors. BILLY THE BULL out broke the field, was rated on the front end, facing no resistance of note, got asked for run upon reaching the end of the bend, arrived at the three-sixteenths marker holding his biggest advantage, failed to protect it, getting caught well past the sixteenth pole. JESSES GIANT DUNK tucked along the rail and rode it to midpoint on the turn, was asked to pick up the pace proceeding to get taken outward at that stage, fanned into the five path during the initial portion of the stretch drive, had a good finish down the outside of the strip, but had to settle for the last major check. TAKAJJO was sent over to the inside and put to encouragement coming to the five-sixteenths pole, failed to make an impact. HARRYTHENAVIGATOR lightly bumped at the start, departed the backstretch from the two path, was no factor. PRIVATE IRVING A away a half beat slowly after breaking to the outside, was asked for some run nearly from the get-go, ranged up steadily during the early stages of the run around the bend, asked for more and more until put to a drive as the half was being set, failed to maintain the momentum and backed away. SUNRISE LOVER saved ground and faltered.
