### Footnotes

OPERATION RED DAWN raced close up outside while well in hand, advanced outside nearing the stretch, responded when roused in upper stretch and drew clear under a drive. RED GIANT was rated along inside, angled out in upper stretch and finished well outside. KRIS ANGEL was outrun early, raced inside and had no rally while between rivals in the stretch. PEGASE JEM (FR) raced in hand outside early, put in a three wide run on the turn and faded in the final furlong. TRICKY CAUSEWAY raced in hand while three wide and had no response when roused. THREE IN THE BAG set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. INDIAN PRAYER was finished after a half mile.
