TOP IT was outrun early after breaking slowly, closed the gap four wide to reach contention at the quarter pole, opened a clear advantage in midstretch then held well while drifting out late. CONVOCATION was under a firm hold along the inside to the far turn, steadied while boxed in on the turn, altered course four wide to get clear entering the stretch and finished well to clearly best the others. CAPE MARCO settled just off the pace, lodged a three wide bid on the turn and weakened in midstretch. CARY AWAY set the pace on the rail for six furlongs and steadily tired thereafter. TIMBER CRUISE raced behind horses in the two path to the turn and gave way. MINER BIRD was never a factor. DANCING WILD was outrun while wide on the turn. PURRRFECT ALIBI pressed three wide for five furlongs and gave way.
