FRANNY FREUD away in good order, ranged up to the pacesetter while well in hand, prompted that one without need of coaxing, moved when ready, taking charge just before completing a half, was put to hand encouragement at the three-sixteenths pole, drew off with authority, before being geared down the final sixteenth. SO N SO broke alertly, showed the way towards the inside with the top one in close proximity alongside, had no answer when that foe made her move on the turn, finished willingly to the wire to preserve place honors. FREUD'S NOTEBOOK raced off the inside, was asked for run on the turn, couldn't keep up with the runaway winner, but continued on well enough to miss the place. POSITIVE PITCH chased four wide for a half and tired. RAFFIE'S ROSE was through after going a half. OMMADON'S ANGEL faded off a ground-saving journey.
