Footnotes

KING TING (IRE) needed only a few jumps out of the starting gate to establish control, tucked along the rail before leaving the opening bend, cut the pace on an open lead and with the rider applying rating tactics, felt some pressure late on the far turn and was set down prior to spinning into the lane, held on safely under a drive down the stretch. QUANTITY unhurried in midpack was under encouragement taking the three path into the stretch, came home willingly to secure second. ANNAWON tracked the front leader from the inside, lacked the needed response. HEAR THE WORD under a snug hold early, was under a drive leaving the five-sixteenths pole, came up empty. WILDCATTER attended the pacesetter from the two path, was under strong handling before reaching the five-sixteenths pole, yet still backed away. IMHOTEP three wide entering the backstretch, issued an abbreviated challenge for command after going six furlongs, flattened out. GUNMAN raced along the outside and trailed.
