MR HALL'S OPUS made light contact with GUYANA QUEEN at the break, raced from between rivals on the turn, was put to encouragement giving chase from the two path between rivals around the bend, turned for home trailing the runner up by only a slim margin, came out on top after a duel from upper to midstretch with ANDELE, edged away the last eighth under good handling. ANDELE got away alertly and was guided over to the inside, showed the way, pressed by two or more until about the quarter pole, reached that station with just the eventual winner applying any serious pressure and was asked for run, fought with vigor but surrendered the lead nearing the end of the run through the furlong grounds, continued onward willingly to be second best. HEART OF ROME three wide and used hard early, proved no match for the top twosome. ZIP CITY MISS four wide until the five-sixteenths pole, tired. GUYANA QUEEN lightly bumped from both sides at the start, was outrun. CABS ARE HERE brushed at the start, failed to reach a contending position despite being set down to a prolonged drive.
