JUNIOR OFFICER bumped after the start several times by L L FLYING NOTES shying away from PAVLOV'S DOG who broke a bit outwards, unleashed a four to five wide sweep to engage the four way pace dispute at the seven-sixteenths, was under hand coaxing continuing the move to take command at the five-sixteenths pole while shifting into the two path now clear of the tiring front, came under rousing at the top of the lane, drew clear with a furlong to go and was kept busy to the end. SHOUTOUT vied in the two path arguing the front with a trio, remained the sole pace battler in contention at the head of the lane, although displaced on the front, ran on well to hold the place through the lane while unable to match the top one. CREA'S LAW tracked the four way pace dispute from just off the inside, came under a drive spinning for home, kicked on belatedly for the show honors while gaining on the aforementioned rival late. OLD KIT BAG allowed to settle early on, raced three wide in the turn, ranged up nearing the quarter pole swinging four wide at that station, displayed a mild kick for the last major share. L L FLYING NOTES exchanged several bumps with the eventual winner shortly after the start when shying from PAVLOV'S DOG who broke a bit inward, was steadied and taken off that rival, crossed to the rail shortly after while being outrun in the early going, came under a busy ride nearing the head of the stretch, rallied by tired foes in the lane. JAZZBO argued the pace inside in a four way pace dispute for a half and faltered. TRINITY WARRIOR disputed the pace four wide for a half and steadily faded thereafter. PAVLOV'S DOG showed brief speed contending the pace from the three path between rivals, gave way after a half.
