Footnotes

JOLIENNE broke alertly, sparred with SCOTT'S ALY CAT while making her way down the backstretch, with IBERIAN GATE in close proximity outside that pair, edged away from the former and was guided over to the rail in time for the run around the bend, maintained a clear advantage from the top of the turn to the quarter pole, entered the stretch and got called upon, extended the margin down the lane while being kept busy. SMARTY BULL three wide entering the turn, was in the five path leaving it, rallied willingly enough to secure second. SCOTT'S ALY CAT a forward factor along the rail, was under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, weakened in the final furlong. BARBARA'S BEAUTY four wide for much of the way on the turn, flattened out. SAY TOBA SANDY

raced from off the inside, was gradually taken outward towards the six path in upper stretch for better racing room, lacked the needed response. SASTA GO LUCKY already under encouragement cutting the corner into the stretch, was angled outward, had no rally. CHICKABUNNY was no factor. IBERIAN GATE contested the pace from the outside on the turn and tired. MYSTICAL RHYTHMS remained under a good hold, awaiting suitable options from the five-sixteenths pole to the quarter pole, ducked in at that station, but had little left to offer for the stretch drive. CRANBERRY QUEEN drifted very wide into upper stretch while tiring. ELUSIVE JOZI three wide at the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a prolonged drive, folded.
