Footnotes

CHARLIE'S PUNCH tracked the pace inside early on, ranged up under his own power to challenge the front taking command just inside the half mile pole, raced in hand along the inside through the turn, got set down at the quarter pole and went clear under a drive. REAGANOMICS hustled from the gate, established the pace from just off the inside, got challenged into the turn then headed inside the half mile pole, gave chased urged from the seven-sixteenths, proved no match for the top one while keeping on mildly for the place. SECRET SHIFTERS three wide within aim of the front in pursuit, came under encouragement three furlongs out, offered up a mild kick to upper stretch before weakening in the late stages while safe for the show. KEVIN SILVERLASPIA coaxed along two to three wide towards the rear, got put to a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths and offered no serious response. TRICKED OUT TUX stumbled at the start, settled just off the inside towards the rear, got pushed along from the three-eighths pole and proved no menace. SIGNOR MARTINI chased four wide early on, retreated placed in the overland route through the turn and tired.
