JARDENIA broke on top but yielded the front soon afterwards to ROMAN RENEGADE, content to take up the role of stalker, ranged up to increase her presence nearing the end of the backstretch, continued as a team with the previously named foe around the turn, struck the top in the very late stages of the run around the bend and proceeded for a couple of jumps into the stretch drive before finally being asked for some run, gradually extended the lead down the lane under good handling. DECORATED COURT reserved in the two path, commenced to angle outward from the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, winding up towards the five path by upper stretch, came home with good energy to win the battle late for place honors. ROMAN RENEGADE moved up into the lead shortly after the start, set the initial split facing only token resistance, but felt more by the time she reached the half mile pole, sparred with the eventual winner on nearly even terms until the quarter pole, surrendered the top despite being the first of the two front runners to have the rider commit to some kind of urging, weakened in the final furlong, losing out on second as well. CHALK PLAYER briefly took the inside route down the backstretch, chose a wider path for the run around the bend, spun from a considerable distance from off the rail into the stretch, drifted out several paths during the initial portion of the stretch run under periodic left handed stick work. READY TO PARTY three to four wide on the turn, crept up to the front runners departing the backstretch, failed to fire appreciably when called upon for the stretch drive. CAT CAN DO underwent a ground-saving journey, was asked early down the backstretch for some run, got put to a drive leaving the midway point on the turn, faded nonetheless.
