Footnotes

D'ORO PRINCESS tracked the front from the three path, commenced a bid under light hand urging on the front from the three-eighths pole, swung four wide in upper stretch now fully engaged by the rider, took over the front at the three-sixteenths, edged clear through the lane kept busy to the end. BID A MOON prompted the pacemaker hard held from the three path, continued under a firm grip until nearing the quarter pole, was let out at that station, took over and led briefly until nearing the three-sixteenths, was displaced at that juncture, proved no match for the winner while running in well to hold the place honors. HARD LIFE crossed to the three path after the start while allowed to settle early on, chased the pace three to four wide through the turn coming under a drive nearing the top of the lane, rallied mildly through the stretch to be along for show honors in the late stages. ROCK STAR ROYALTY set the pace from the two path accompanied by a keen and well held rival, was under light coaxing approaching the three-eighths to maintain the front, got set down turning for home, was displaced at the quarter pole, faded through the lane drifting out late while tiring. CASA TUA midpack under reserve and saving ground, was pushed along from the five-sixteenths, weakened in the late stages. GRANBY GIRL tracked the pace from just off the inside in the two path, came under encouragement at the head of the lane while three wide and offered little. MOONSHINE MAGIC settled towards the rear while taking the overland route throughout and offered no response. MINER'S TUNE saved ground towards the rear, came under a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths, offered no kick and was not persevered with in the final furlong.
