Footnotes

ADRIATIC DREAM sat well reserved at or near the back of the pack for the opening half, departed the backstretch two wide and was under some hand urging during the run around the full turn, got fanned out into the five path for entrance into the stretch, was straightened away and began to close the gap on the front runners, made up real estate more readily leaving the eighth pole, collared the runner up late to prove best. HEART OF NEW YORK patiently rode the rail for the initial six furlongs, was taken outward and spun into the stretch four wide, settled into upper lane before getting called upon, closed in with a rush to be the widest of three on nearly even terms at the eighth pole, took over shortly afterwards and extended the lead out to its biggest, by a good length with slightly less than a sixteenth remaining, dug in well but got nipped at the end. EUROKAY BY ME was strung out in the three path at the head of the backstretch, prompted the leader proceeding towards the half mile pole, scooted past SIMPLISTIC, as did PORVOO at that station and tucked into the two path, vied for command from there the rest of the way around the bend, turned for home and was set down to a strong drive, beat several others to arrive at the furlong marker holding a slim advantage, surrendered to HEAT OF NEW YORK afterwards when unable to hold off that opponent and eventually weakened into the show slot. CHLOE BEAR unhurried along the outside for a half, was guided over onto the inside route at the top of the turn, scurried into contention, was kept on hold, caught behind traffic for a few strides prior to the quarter pole, had the rail route open up when the obstructing rival got angled out three wide into the stretch, launched a solid run from upper to midstretch to loom boldly with an eighth to go, couldn't sustain it and flattened out. PORVOO secured a forward position shortly after the start, prompted the pace from the outside for the initial half, edged to the front and tucked along the rail near the top of the turn, came under heavy pressure heading for the top of the lane and was asked for run in response, gave in to it in the furlong grounds and faltered. SIMPLISTIC vied for the lead along the inside for slightly more than a half, yielded and fell back slightly, was set to a drive angling three wide into the stretch, gave way. FANTASTIC EYES departed the elbow chute from the three path, took the same one around the full turn, entered the stretch under strong handling, tired. MLLE MARGAUX along the inside for nearly three-quarters, swung three wide into the stretch under encouragement, folded.
