PLAINVIEW on the pace inside, got set down cutting the corner into the stretch, edged clear to the eighth pole, saw his margin cut into late on while kept to task to prevail safely. KHARAFa just off the pace just off the inside, remained patiently handled in behind a wall of rivals through the far turn, swung four to five wide in upper stretch, angled out for a clear path, rallied with good energy albeit belatedly for the place honors. AMPERSAND three wide towards the rear, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, progressed four to five wide at the quarter pole, offered up a mild kick into the stretch. GIMME CREDIT tracked the pace along the inside from mid pack, advanced into contention cutting the corner into the stretch roused, kicked on mildly for the late major share. RUTHLESS ALLEY three wide in pursuit within aim urged from the seven-sixteenths, weakened in the stretch. CITIZEN WELLS three wide towards the rear devoid of early speed, came under encouragement three furlongs out, swung four wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals. CANTONIC attended the pace maker early on three wide, gave chased from the two path when shaken off a bit into the far turn, came under urging at the five-sixteenths and weakened after straightening for home. IDLE AMERICAN three to four wide towards the rear early on, raced a bit eager down the backside, was given

some rein to work with and advanced four wide into contention nearing the quarter pole before tiring in the stretch. GIANT INDIAN a bit keen stargazing early on against the restraint of the rider out of the dog legged turn, saved ground towards the rear, came under a prolonged drive from the half mile pole and made no impact. REACHING OUT forwardly placed inside, retreated after a half and was eased in the stretch.
