KHAN OF KHANS away alertly, quickly established command, set the pace, under a good hold, and placed in the two path, rebuffed the runner up's bid coming to the quarter pole, with the rider sitting chilly in contrast to the energetic riding tactics being applied by the challenger's pilot, was finally given his cue nearing the eighth pole and held sway, being kept busy throughout the last eighth. CROWN THE CHIEF gave chase on the top one from the three path, was put to a hard drive from the quarter pole, but could make no headway on the winner and had to settle for place honors. PAX off the inside, was asked for a response midway on the turn but proved no match for the two pair. TARGHEE PASS three wide at the half mile pole, had no rally. PETE'S PARLEY four wide departing the backstretch, was through after completing a half. STRICTLY SOCIETY leapt up at the start, brushing into the left side of the gate as well, was lightly urged into midpack, sat reserved from there, got called upon entering the stretch but had no response. SEEKING ANITA raced along the outside and was outrun. PAVORATTI'S SOUL was outrun.
