CURLINA moved up to contest the pace with LET'S GET FISCAL soon after the start, vied towards the three path with that opponent, requiring only the mildest of encouragement to stay on even terms, shook free shortly after entering the turn, was put to a vigorous hand ride for the stretch drive, emerged from the furlong grounds with a comfortable advantage and safely maintained it. VICTORIA LYNN four wide departing the backstretch, got out finished in the lane. COSSET unhurried in the two path for nearly three-quarters, rallied for the show. ROSE'S TURN underwent a four wide pursuit, was asked for a response from midway on the turn but had no gain. CHRISTINA D'ORO raced along the outside, turned for home under a drive, but could not muster up the needed response. GOLDEN GALLEON three wide, tired. LET'S GET FISCAL the early leader, was soon joined by the top one, disputed the pace from the two path for about six furlongs before backing away.
