JUSTIN PHILLIP was hand urged to secure a forward post, kept up with the pace combatants from the three path, put to some coaxing to do, picked up interest approaching the head of the stretch and was soon called upon, drove past the front runners to arrive at the eighth pole with a clear advantage, added to it under good handling. HILLSWICK broke on top but was quickly joined by W. W.'S LADY MAN, got hooked up in the two path with that opponent through lively fractions, struck the front just as the field turned for home, was collared by the winner but continued on willingly to procure the place. W. W.'S LADY'S MAN came out slightly making light contact with WINNING TOUCH as a result, drew alongside the runner up and initiated a duel, raced heads apart with the second place finisher, stubbornly clinging to the narrowest of margins until just before the quarter pole, fell back a sliver at that station, remained a prominent factor for a little while longer then weakened. WINNING TOUCH brushed with W. W.'S LADY MAN leaving the starting gate, gave chase from off the inside, spun four wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response. TEMECULA CREEK saved ground and made no serious moves.
