**Footnotes**

MOONLIT SONNET vied for the lead, with the rider applying rating tactics until the quarter pole, picked up speed when let out turning for home and scampered away from the others to draw well clear by the end. STOCK FUND underwent a three wide journey and rallied for the place. SAMUELS BLOND LADY saved ground until the quarter pole, was put to some encouragement angling out for the start of the stretch run, flattened out. HURRICANE JACKIE three wide departing the elbow chute, was placed in the four path coming to the five-sixteenths marker, failed to muster up a solid closing punch. CELESTA off the inside, rushed up while slightly headstrong soon after departing the backstretch until closing in precariously upon LIFE'S A STAGE, was tipped outward in the direction of the three path but not in time to avoid initiating solid contact with the previously named foe, continued at a considerable distance from off the rail and came up empty in the stretch. FAMILYOFROSES three wide entering the turn, was in the five path exiting it, lacked the needed response. LIFE'S A STAGE reserved near the two path while sitting within striking distance, was bumped an errant CELESTA coming to the three-eighths pole, tired steadily after spinning into the stretch. MIZ OWELL saved ground during the initial stages, was taken outward until three wide near the top of the full turn, fanned six wider entering the stretch, had nothing to offer. CHRISSY GIRL placed to a firm hold after leaving the starting gate, raced with keenness, making a four wide to momentarily grab the advantage, settled down significantly as the winner reclaimed the advantage, stalked that opponent the rest of the way down the backstretch, with about a lane of space separating the front runners, drew alongside at the half mile pole, pressed the issue for nearly the entire way to the quarter pole, appeared to be in the initial stages of backing away when forced to steady as SAMUELS BLOND LADY was angling outward at that juncture, reached the top of the lane and gave way.
