Footnotes

ISLAND SUNSET saved ground in mid pack initially, advanced three wide through the turn racing in hand to be on nearly even terms at the quarter pole for the front, swung three wide into the stretch, took over at the three-sixteenths, inched away to the final furlong, dug in under a drive as his main threat reasserted himself and held on repulsing that challenge on the wire. SHANKOPOTAMUS cut the pace inside under light coaxing, got let out spinning just off the inside into the stretch challenged by the aforementioned rival, got headed near the three-sixteenths, dug in under a drive to narrow the advantage again through the final sixteenth fighting on well down inside and just missed. GAME TOKEN saved ground towards the rear, came under encouragement three furlongs out, angled out four wide at the head of the stretch, offered up a mild kick for the show honors. AFTERNOON TREAT two to three wide towards the rear, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, angled six wide in upper stretch and passed tired rivals in the stretch. CROWN THE CHIEF hustled from the start, chased from just off the inside within aim ridden along from midway on the turn and weakened in the stretch. LITTLE WYATT broke out at the start, raced three to four wide in pursuit from just off the pace, got asked at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide in upper stretch and tired. DR. WESLEY tracked the pace along the inside from close range, lost position nearing the quarter pole, angled four wide at that station and was briefly paused as GAME TOKEN angled out in front then tired in the stretch.
