Footnotes

FRONT forwardly placed in the early stages, came up tight upon HYMAN ROTH's heels just before reaching the end of the opening bend, checked and fell back three lengths with the resulting loss of momentum, was given some rein and briefly rushed up to sit a tighter pocket trip shortly afterwards, kept pace within range biding time during the run around the far turn, turned for home lacking optimal clearance, found space and altered course to the outside in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, settled into his best stride after completing the maneuver, charged past the leader to take over with a furlong to go, and edged away, kept busy to the end. TOY CANNON three wide on the first turn, was closer to the inside on the next bend, swung five wide into upper stretch and came home with good energy to procure the place. GOSSIP COLUMN guided over to the rail midway down the backstretch, was kept from being asked for his best, lacking the best of sailing room from late on the far turn to almost midstretch, angled outward with an eighth to go and came home willingly for the show. NOOSH'S TALE strung out four wide on the first turn, was along the rail well before arriving at the top of the next one, stayed along the inside until approaching the quarter pole, managed to tip two wide for the commencement of the stretch run, didn't stay in that path for too long, gradually working his way to be five wide by midlane, got straightened away and displayed a good kick to secure the final major check. MR ALGEBRA three wide to four wide on the each bend, although closer to the rail down the backstretch, lacked the needed response. HYMAN ROTH gained a slight advantage after a few strides out of the starting gate, tucked along the inside route a short distance prior to setting foot on the main course, but not before placing the winner into enough of a predicament to force its pilot to have to check, rated kindly along the rail facing honest resistance from the closest pursuer, reached the quarter pole with an increase in the pressure and was turned loose, fell victim to the winner's burst of speed deep into the furlong grounds and yielded, weakened steadily thereafter. GHOSTLY VISION appeared eager in the early stages, made an abbreviated run after entering the backstretch to confront the front runners, settled down afterwards and fell back into midpack, raced at or near the overland route throughout, had little left after completing three-quarters. BEYOND EMPIRE prompted the pacesetter from the outside until midpoint on the far turn and gave way. IN MY EYES three wide around both turns, was asked for run past the five-sixteenths pole, folded.
